


International license

International licence: partner

International licence: rule



• Athletes, coaches and officials who wish to participate in Championships, Games, International and National Tournaments, which are recognised or controlled by World Archery or a Member Association, in one or more of the various disciplines recognised by World Archery, shall be affiliated with a Member Association and have a valid international license (until such time that the Executive Board adopts bylaws as to international license requirements, an athlete's, coaches' and official's membership in his Member Association shall constitute a valid international license.)

International licence: approach



• All registrations through WAREOS need a licence. All registrations through Open Wareos don't need one




- 1. Will this license cover health insurance for the athletes and officials during all competitions in 2022?
- →No only tournaments where entries were done through WAREOS. So basically World Ranking tournaments, World Championships and Continental Championships
- 2. Can you specify which competition will need to have licence?
 - World Ranking tournaments (including EGP, Asian cup,...)
 - World Games
 - Continental Championships
- 3. Youth Events and Indoor Championships don't count towards World Ranking, do they need a license?




- Cost: one payment per year/federation athlete or official
 - It is linked to the person not per event
 - 100 CHF
 - Calendar year (01.01 31.12)
- **Includes:** travel and health insurance

→ Yes






- Registration would be through the accreditation process and the invoice would be at the end of the year like for calendar tournaments and membership fees or at the first event the person participates
 - A digital certificate of the licence will be available
 - A federation can opt for payment at the first event an athlete participates but cannot have a mix of the two systems.



Illness or accident


- outpatient care (doctors, medicines and tests)
- hospitalisation costs
- Pandemics such as COVID-19 (treated as illnesses)
- Disability or death following an accident:
 - the amount of services provided are subject to status and the level of cover
 - non-accidental deaths (e.g. due to cardiac arrest or stroke) are also covered, subject to status

Luggage and personal effects

- luggage delays
- delayed or cancelled flights (more than 4 hours)
- theft, damage or loss of luggage by the carrier
- Report any theft to the police and complete the online claim form



Insurance: claim



- Log in to <u>www.imssa.org</u>
 - ID: WA
 - Password: 22A966567
- www.imssa.org makes it easy for you to submit a claim for reimbursement for:
 - Illness or accident
 - Lost, stolen or delayed luggage
 - Flight or trip cancellation (COVID-19)
- Reimbursement is always by bank transfer to the federation or to the affected person
- It takes maximum 30 days, provided that all information is submitted with the claim

Requirements for the competition

- World Archery competition rules
- recognised event (registered in WA calendar)
- judges at least national level

Who should claim?

- member association of LOC
- if your archer shoots World Record in another country and not sure if the LOC MA is claiming the record, contact them and WA

How to claim a World Record?

- within 10 days
- extranet online form
- attach the copy of scorecard and full results
- by claiming MA confirms that the World Archery rules were followed and requirements for World Record fulfilled

- As of February 2022
- Upon validation by World Archery
- Certificates will not be sent by post mail anymore
- Certificates will be given to MA team/officials in World Archery events or directly to athletes with MA approval


