

Welcome to Nordic Youth Championships (NUM) 2025



It is with great pleasure that the archery club Borås Bågskyttesällskap, in collaboration with World Archery Sweden, World Archery Nordic and the City of Borås, invites you to NUM 2025.

Ryda Sportfält in Borås will be the setting for a fantastic championship from Thursday, July 3th to Sunday, July 6th.



Shooting

Competition will be held in all bow types and age categories according to the WA Nordic rules. Additionally, each class is divided between boys and girls.

The youngest allowed age is archers born in 2012.

The oldest allowed age is archers born in 2005.

All archers must bring identification such as a passport with documentation of their birthdate and year.

RU21 Open is to archers in Recurve who are not comfortable shooting the long distances. This class is open to all archers, ranging from 13 years old to 20 years old, but it is likely most relevant for the U18 and U21 age groups.

Only accredited archers and coaches have access to the shooting range itself. Parents and spectators are directed behind the shooting line.

Each nation is allocated one coach accreditation for every 3 archers they have registered. Coaches are encouraged to wear their nation's T-shirt.

There will be team finals on Sunday and the teams will be put together so there can be mixed teams with participants from different countries.

Shooting equipment can be stored in the Borås Bågskyttesällskap's clubhouse, which is located near the venue, if you do not want to take it with you to your accommodation.

Accommodation

We offer accommodation in a school (Bodaskolan) with a bring-your-own air mattress etc. in collaboration with Borås Stad. Breakfast and dinner is included in the fee and served at the school (lunch is included in the tournament fee). There will be access to showers. Participating countries' coaches are required to be at the accommodation with the archers and ensure that order is maintained.

The price is EUR 50 per person per night and the accommodation is available from Thursday.

Food and drinks

Lunch on Friday and Saturday from a catering company is included in the tournament fee for all shooters. Water is served with lunch. Lunch is served in a tent near the shooting range.

Coaches, other representatives of participating countries and parents can pre-order lunch which is paid in advance. The cost is EUR 11. Order here: www.num2025.se/lunch or via the registration excel.

At the competition there will be a service that provides coffee, tea, drinks, snacks, cookies, sandwiches, hamburgers, sausages, sweets etc. The service is cashless and all prices are in SEK (1 SEK is approx. 0.09 EUR). Payment at the service can only be made by debit card or Swish for Swedish customers and Vipps/MobilePay for customers from Norway, Denmark and Finland.

Deadlines, registration, and tournament fees

Registration opens May 1st and the regular registration deadline is Thursday June 12th.

Registration is sent on a national basis to registration@num.se

Registration is only valid once the registration fee is paid. Registration is binding.

For regular registration, no later than June 12th, the following prices apply:

Tournament fee: EUR 150. This includes competition participation and lunch Friday and Saturday.

We aim to publish a participant list as soon as possible afterward on lanseo.

The final registration deadline is Thursday June 19th and thereafter, no late registrations will be possible.

For registration between June 12th and June 19th, there will be an additional fee of 60 Euros per archer.

How to arrive

Ryda Sportfält is located on Almenäsvägen in Borås. Signs will show where to turn off the road to get to the competition. The number of parking spaces directly adjacent to the competition is limited, but there is a large parking lot just a 5-minute walk from the field.

Landvetter Airport is a 35-minute drive from the competition and transportation to and from the airport is available for an additional cost. Contact claes@borasbs.se for more information.

Rental cars can be rented at Landvetter Airport via www.hertz.se

Borås Resecentrum is the hub for trains and buses and it is possible to take local transport from there to the competition site, but you may have to walk a bit.

Travel to and from accommodation (Bodaskolan and hotels in Borås) and the competition venue Thursday-Sunday can be booked at a cost of 50 EUR/person.
