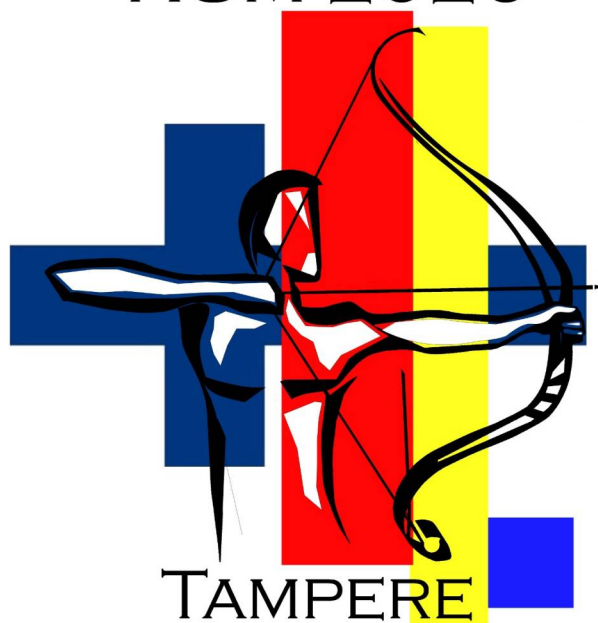


Welcome to Nordic Youth Championships (NUM) 2026

It is with great pleasure that the archery club Tampereen Jousiampujat, in collaboration with the Finnish Archery Association and World Archery Nordic, invites you to NUM 2026. Mustavuori Archery Center in Tampere will be the setting for a fantastic championship from Thursday, July 2nd to Sunday, July 5th.

Competition Format

The competition will be held for all bow types and age/gender classes in accordance with WA Nordic rules.

The youngest eligible archers are those born in 2013, and the oldest are those born in 2006. All participants must bring identification, such as a passport, to verify their date of birth.

The competition will have following shooting categories, distances and targets.

The RU21 Open is intended for Recurve archers who are not yet comfortable shooting at longer distances. This class is open to all archers aged 13 to 20, though it is primarily intended for the U18 and U21 age groups.

Only accredited archers and coaches are permitted on the shooting range. Parents and spectators must remain in the stand.

Each nation will be allocated one coach accreditation for every three registered archers. Coaches are encouraged to wear their national team apparel.

Team finals will take place on Saturday. As the teams are defined by the competition organizers, there can also be mixed teams with participants from different countries.

Registration Information

Registration process

Registration for NUM 2026 must be completed via national associations. Finnish Archery Association will provide registration forms (Excel document) for national associations. As an alternative, national associations can do registrations via Google Forms.

Registration opens on May 1st, and the deadline for regular registration is **Sunday, May 31st**. Registration is only valid once the fee has been paid in full. All registrations are binding.

Registration fees and deadlines

- Regular registration (**by May 31st**): 160€. This fee covers competition entry and lunch on Friday and Saturday.
- Late registration (**June 1st – June 14th**): An additional late fee of 60€ per archer will apply.

The final deadline for all entries is Thursday, June 14th. No registrations will be accepted after this date. We aim to publish the participant list on lanseo as soon as possible following the registration deadline.

All competitors will also receive free travel rights on local buses and trams (Nysse) during the competition days. This can be used for traveling to competition center from school accommodation and hotel from city center.

Accommodation

School accommodation

School accommodation is offered at Tesoma school (Kohmankaari 11, Tampere). Participants must bring their own air mattresses and bedding. Access to showers will be available on-site.

- **Price:** 50€ per person, per night.
- **Availability:** Starting Thursday.
- **Meals:** The accommodation fee includes breakfast and evening snack, both served at the school.
- **Supervision:** To ensure order is maintained, coaches from participating countries are required to stay at the school with their archers (1 coach per each 10 archers).
- **Distances:** 3.5km to competition center, 10km to Tampere city center
- **Transportation options:** Bus line [number 7](#) runs school accommodation and Mustavuori competition center.
- **Notes:** Shopping center [Westeri](#) with a supermarket and restaurants is close by.

Hotels

Participants can get a discount on room reservations at Scandic hotels in Tampere and Nokia (booking code EVNT). Through below link, guests can directly book rooms with discounted rate: <https://www.scandichotels.com/en?bookingcode=EVNT>

Guests can choose their preferred room type, and receive an additional discount when paying for the reservation upon booking. The cancellation policy for individual bookings depends on the booking type chosen by the guest. To confirm the reservation, guests must provide a valid credit card information. Rooms are subject to availability and should be booked 10 days before arrival at the latest.

Arriving to Tampere

By plane

Tampere-Pirkkala airport

There are no direct flight connections from other Nordic countries to [Tampere-Pirkkala airport](#). However, [airBaltic](#) offers flights to Tampere with a transfer in Riga, Latvia.

From airport you can either rent a car, pick a taxi or travel to Tampere city center by bus. See [Tampere-Pirkkala airport](#) web pages for more information.

Please note that available return flights from Tampere-Pirkkala are very limited during Sunday.

Helsinki airport

An alternative for flying to Tampere is to fly instead to [Helsinki airport](#) and then travel from there to Tampere. There are several airlines flying directly from other Nordic countries to Helsinki, including [Finnair](#), [SAS](#) and [airBaltic](#).

From airport you can travel to Tampere by a rental car, bus or train (via Tikkurila railway station). See [Helsinki airport](#) web pages for more information.

By train or bus

There are several train and bus connections per day to Tampere from all major Finnish cities:

If you wish to use public transport to reach the school accommodation after arriving in Tampere, we recommend taking [a local train](#) from the Tampere Railway Station to Tesoma Station. 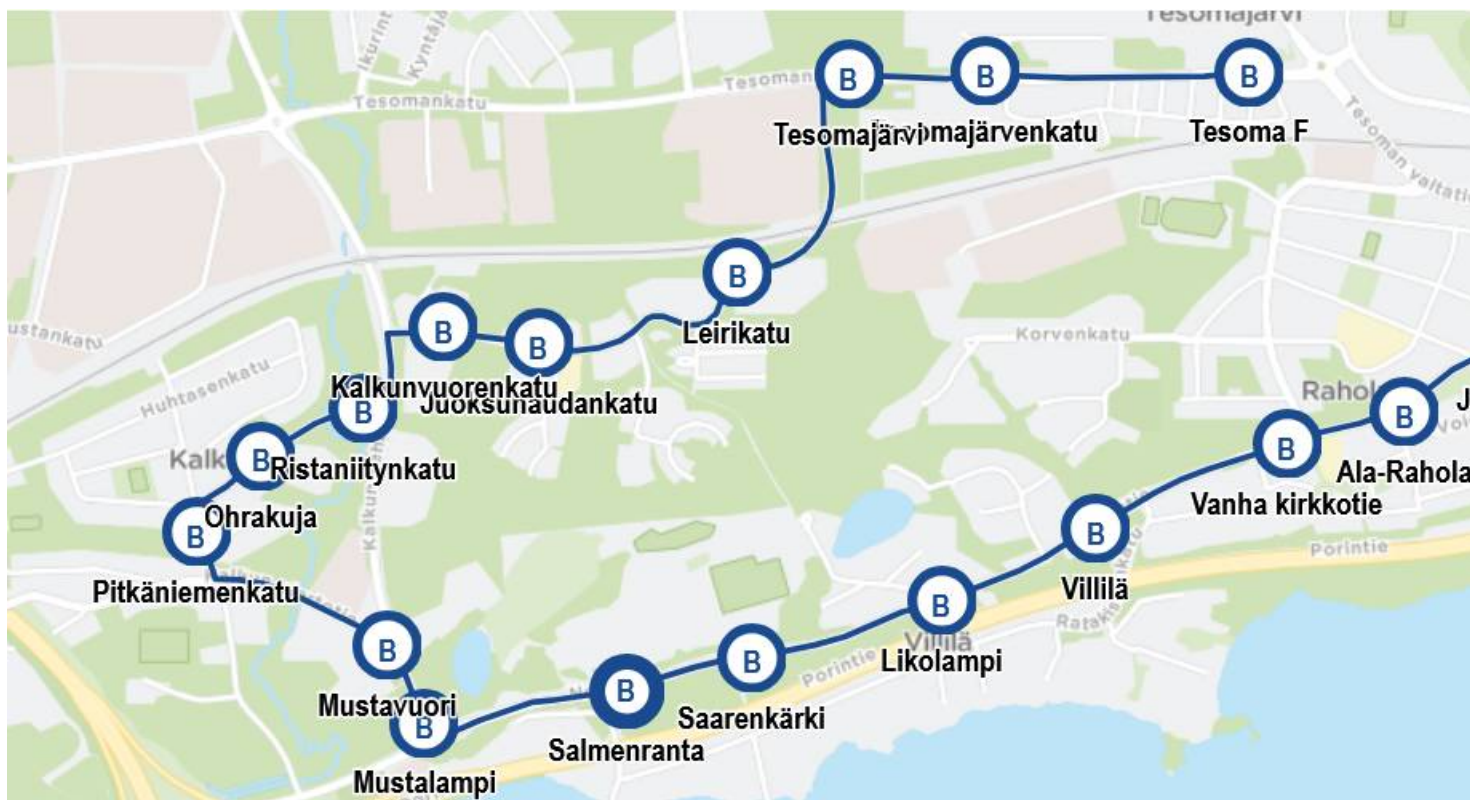

Local transportation

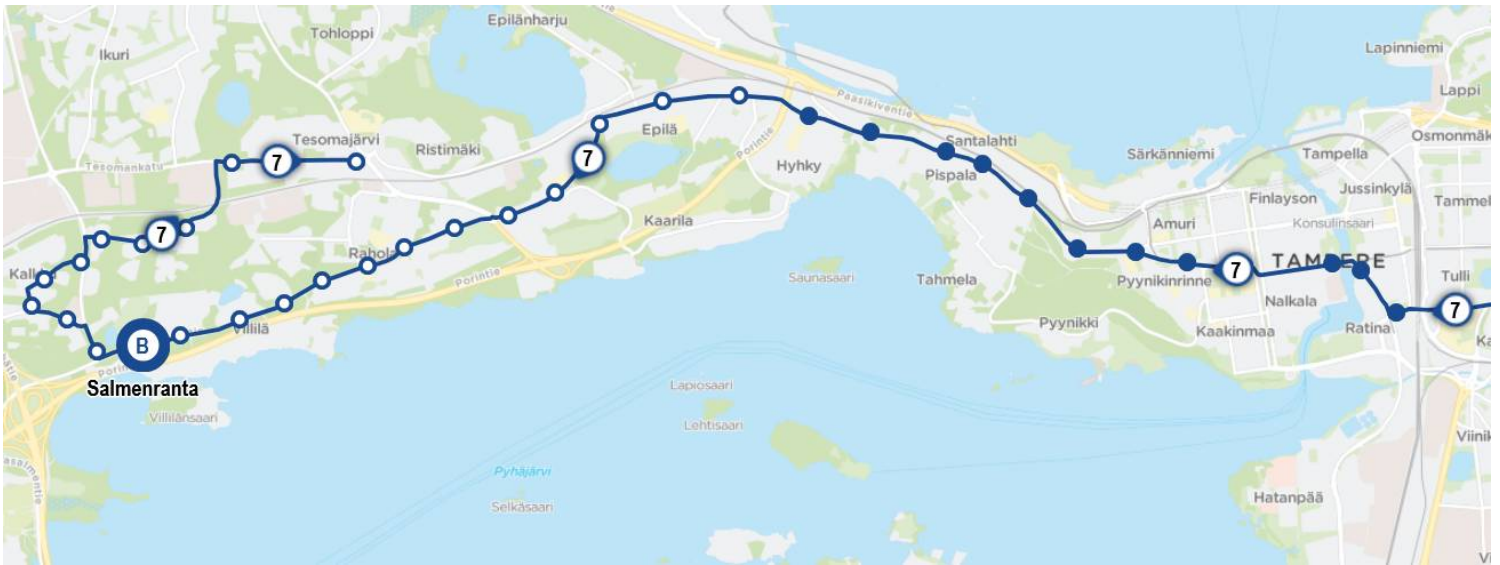
Public transport

All competitors will receive free travel rights on local buses and trams (Nysse) during the competition days. We will also offer the same transport ticket option for coaches and parents as part of a package which includes also lunches in competition center.

The method for transport between the school accommodation and competition center is local public transport. Bus line [number 7](#) runs regularly between Tesoma center and Mustavuori competition center (bus stop [Salmenranta, 1767](#)). The bus stop in Tesoma (Tesoma F) is about 500 meters from school accommodation in front of shopping center Westeri. See below map for more information.



Same bus line ([number 7](#)) runs also between Tampere city center and Mustavuori competition center (bus stop [Salmenranta, 1768](#)). This is one option for traveling to competition center for those participants who are staying in hotels at the city center. See map on the next page for more information.



In case you want to buy ticket yourself to local transport, it is recommended to get a day ticket (zones AB) which allows free travel on buses, trams and trains in the Nysse area during a 24h period. See [Nysse website](#) for more information.

Taxis

There are several taxi companies operating in Tampere area and you can always get a taxi from any taxi stand at the city center. E.g. Uber, Bolt and Taksi Tampere are few of the taxi companies operating in Tampere area.

Car

For those who arrive to Mustavuori competition center either by own or rental car, there is a large parking area available next to competition center. See next page for more information.

Competition center

Mustavuori archery center

Mustavuori archery center has been opened in summer 2023 and is located at Mustavuori sports center in Western Tampere. The field has width of 150 meters and allows about 280 competitors to shoot at the same time, thus enabling arranging of even large competitions. The field is surfaced with astro turf and has a stand from where audience can follow shooting.

The address for the archery center is Nokiantie 150, Tampere.

Parking area and bus stop

Mustavuori parking area is next to the competition center, no parking fees apply. The archery center is about 300 meters from the bus stop and the parking area.

Meals and drinks

Breakfast and evening snack

For participants staying at the school accommodation, prepackaged breakfast and evening snack will be served on-site. Both breakfast and evening snack are included to the accommodation fee. Please see menu in the last page.

Lunch

Lunch from Friday to Sunday is included in the tournament fee for all archers. Water will be served with the meal. Lunch will be served at the restaurant near the competition center (please refer to the map above). Please see menu in the last page.

Lunch and transport package for coaches, team representatives, and parents

Coaches, team representatives, and parents may per-order a package containing:

- Lunches at competition center for Friday – Sunday.
- Free travel rights on local buses and trams (Nysse) during the competition days.

This package costs 50€ per person and must be ordered & paid for in advance at the same time as the tournament registration. Please see menu in the last page.

Privacy Notice: Nordic (Youth) Championships 2026

1. Who is responsible?

This event is hosted by Tampereen Jousiampujat (hereafter referred to as LOC) on behalf of World Archery Nordic (WAN). WAN is a general term referring to the cooperation of the Nordic national archery federations.

Your data is collected by your national club (with parental consent when applicable) and shared with your national federation (WAN Member) for registration purposes. The national federation compiles the list from all clubs and sends the official registration list to the event LOC. No data is sold to third-party marketers. Your data is processed jointly by the LOC and your national federation to manage the registration, competition, official rankings, and results.

2. Purpose & Legal Basis

- **Registration & Participation:** Your name, gender, date of birth, club, country, dietary needs and other relevant information is collected to manage your entry and safety (Contractual Necessity).
- **Historical Archiving:** Final results (such as name, gender, division, class, score, country/club represented) will be permanently published and archived as a matter of Public Interest.
- **Media:** Photos and videos will be taken, published and stored for the promotion of the sport during and after the event and to serve as a historical record of archery participation in the Nordic countries (Legitimate Interests). You may opt-out by contacting the registration desk at the event. A bright coloured ribbon, lanyard or similar will be provided to you by the LOC that you must wear to notify all media and other participants at the event to avoid taking identifiable photos or videos of you. During alternate shooting livestreams if one athlete has opted out the cameras will not show that athlete during the streaming of that match and will only show the athletes target face during the match, the other athlete may be shown. If both athletes have opted out then only the target faces of the match will be shown and not the athletes.

3. Data Sharing & Retention

Administrative data will be deleted at the latest 2 years after the event. Dietary and medical requirements will be deleted within 30 days of the event conclusion. Competition results are kept indefinitely for sporting history.

4. Your Rights

You can request erasure of all your data or some of your data (for example a specific photo or video) from the relevant party at any time by contacting them. Note that erasure of official competition results is generally not possible as they form part of a permanent historical record (GDPR Article 89).
